



Traceability to Plantations

Facility: PT. Pacific Medan Industri (Pamin)

Period: 2022

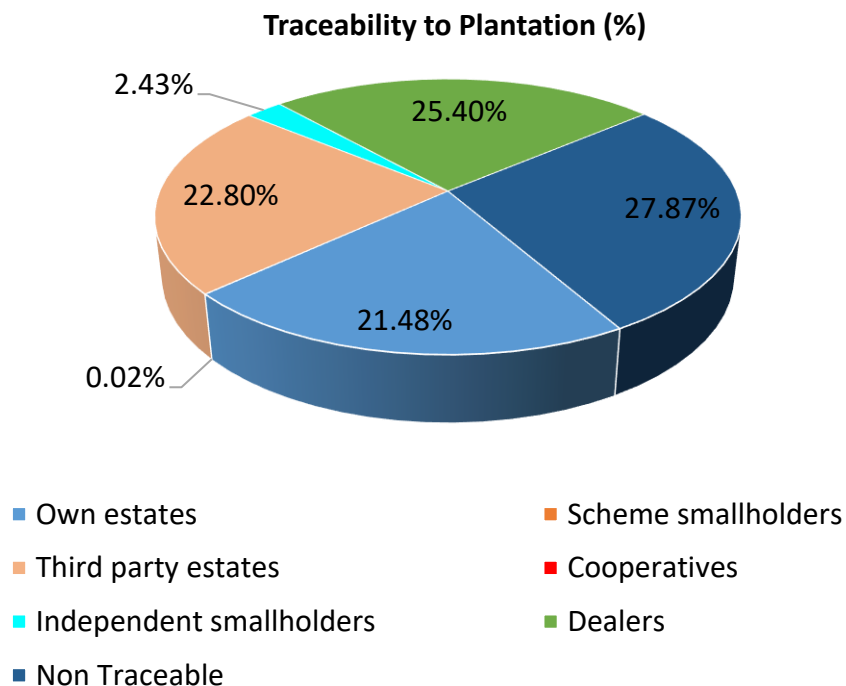
PT. Pacific Medan Industri is 60.59% traceable to plantation.

Sources of fresh fruit bunches (FFB) supplied to the mills which in turn supply crude palm oil (CPO) to Pamin is made up of:

- I. Estates – estates owned by the mills and third-party estates
- II. Smallholders – scheme/plasma and independent smallholders that supplies FFB directly to our supplying mills
- III. Dealers – who source FFB from various origins

In 2022, 5.88% of our supplying mills sourced FFB from their own plantations only while another 41.18% of mills sourced FFB from third party plantations. Remaining 52.94% of mill sourced from both own and third party plantations. Third party plantation refers to various sources such independent plantations, smallholders, cooperatives and dealers.

In terms of volume of FFB traceable, 21.48% was sourced from mill's own plantation, 0.02% from scheme smallholders, 22.80% from third party plantations, 2.43% from independent smallholders, and 25.40% from dealers.



We consider the source of FFB as traceable when the following information is provided by the supplying mills.
